**Please see below information about the Swimathon- we currently do not have enough entrants to take part.**



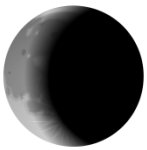
## Mother's Day Service

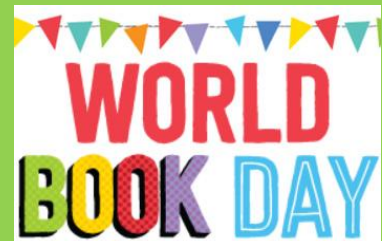
