## Little Dalby Visits

This term each base will have a visit to the Ernest Cook Trust at Little Dalby. During the visits, our staff will work alongside qualified education officers from the outdoor learning centre taking learning out of the classroom into the great outdoors. Using the Ernest Cook Trust's farm and woodland areas, the children will learn about farming and agriculture, wildlife, biodiversity and natural habitats first hand.

As these are outdoor visits, your children will need to arrive at school suitably dressed. Long trousers/jogging bottoms are essential (jeans are not advisable as they can be very uncomfortable if they get wet). We suggest that you send a spare pair of trousers and shoes in a carrier bag so that the children can change if necessary. They will also need wellies, a waterproof coat, hat and gloves if the weather is forecast to be cold.
